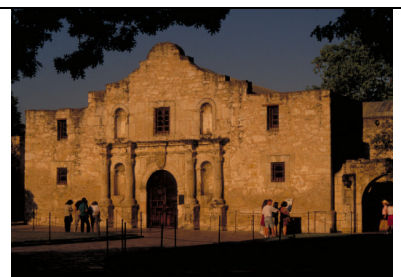


San Antonio and the Texas Hill Country

The Alamo and the IMAX film presentation “Alamo – Price of Freedom”.

The most famous spot in Texas, where, in 1836, 189 defenders fell after repeated attacks by Mexican General Santa Anna’s army. The chapel is one of the most photographed facades in the nation. The museum contains relics and mementos from the Republic of Texas.

San Antonio Riverwalk and boat excursion on the San Antonio River.

Paseo Del Rio, in the heart of downtown, is the pride of the city. Lush green foliage lines the banks of this peaceful, historic river. Cobblestone walkways lead visitors to the river-level restaurants and shops. The river threads its way through the city one level below the hustle and bustle of city streets. Along the horseshoe shaped riverbend, the river is shaded by towering cypresses, oaks and willows and bordered by gardens of flowering ornamental plants.

American Heritage sites - Mission San José and Spanish colonial architecture.

Visit the San Fernando Cathedral, the spiritual center of San Antonio for over 250 years, and the oldest cathedral in the U.S., the Spanish governor’s palace and the Mexican Market, and the largest and best known of the Texas Missions, San José, considered "Queen of the Missions", the model among Texas missions, where 300 inhabitants were sustained by the vast fields and herds of livestock.

Texas Hill Country full day excursion - LBJ Ranch and historic Fredericksburg.

Tour the Johnson Homestead, home of our 36th president, Lyndon Baines Johnson. Then meet the friendly people of Fredericksburg, Texas - local artisans, winemakers, craftsmen and shop owners who have been mixing German heritage with Texan hospitality in a colorful and cultural blend of architecture, cuisine, art, and music. Visit the National Museum of the Pacific War in the former hotel once owned by Admiral Nimitz’s family.
